# Experiencing or Encountering God



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Even the fruits of the Spirit are an experience.

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Even the fruits of the Spirit are an experience.

Consider the experience of each of these.

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But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Galatians 5:22-23

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Our testimony about them deals with our experience.

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Being filled with the Holy Spirit is an experience.

Regeneration is an experience.

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Worship is an experience.

Faith is an experience.

Suffering and deliverance are experiences.

Divine power is something we experience.

Fellowship (*koinōnia*) is an experience.

And prayer is an experience.

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In fact, almost everything about the Holy Spirit and His interaction with us can be described as an experience that draws us closer to the Lord.

# The Holy Spirit

The Spirit as our Comforter

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“And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another (*állos*) Helper (*paráklētos* – to comfort, encourage, or exhort), that He may abide with you forever— the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows (*ginōskō*) Him; but you know (*ginōskō*) Him, (how) for He dwells with you and will be in you.”

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“And when He (Holy Spirit) has come, He will convict (*elégchō* – to prove one in the wrong and thus to shame him and show him to be guilty) the world (*elégchō* – which includes you and me) of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment.”

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“For as many as are led (*ágō* – to lead, bring forth, carry) by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.”

# The Holy Spirit

Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. (how) For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession (*huperentugchánō* – to appeal or plead on behalf of someone) for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

Romans 8:26-27

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Have you ever had the experience where, when you couldn't pray or didn't know what to say, somehow, someone was praying for you, and you could tell that was happening.

In fact, you knew you were connecting with God in prayer even when you had no clue what to pray for.
